



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
LACKAWANNA COLLEGE
AND
WAYNE HIGHLANDS SCHOOL DISTRICT

PURPOSE:

This Articulation Agreement (this "Agreement") is valid effective July 1, 2022.

Wayne Highlands School District ("WHSD") and Lackawanna College ("LC") enter this Agreement, effective July 1, 2022, in order to facilitate the matriculation of students from the WHSD to LC and to support their academic success in LC's Agribusiness Associate Degree.

AREAS OF AGREEMENT:

This Agreement will be applicable for students who have completed the WHSD Applied Horticulture Program and who wish to pursue an A.S. degree in Agribusiness from LC.

This Agreement will not be applicable to students entering LC with limited credits or students transferring without completing the WHSD General Applied Horticulture Program.

Under the terms of this Agreement, students who have completed the General Agriculture Program will be granted credit for the following courses:

-ECL 115 Sustainable Agriculture (3 credits)

*-AGR 105 Basic Farm Maintenance (3 credits) ***Completion of Metal I at WHSD required*

-AGR 120 Plant Science (3 credits)

-AGR 235 Soil Science (3 credits)

This agreement does not guarantee acceptance into the college. LC reserves the right to accept/deny students as per LC's Admissions Policy.

To facilitate the matriculation of students from WHSD to LC in accordance with the above stipulations, the parties involved agree to the following:

Students entering the agreement must:


1. Have successfully completed the Applied Horticulture Program at the WHSD.
2. Complete the Standard Admissions Process at LC.

***Any WHSD students utilizing Dual Enrollment credits taken while in high school will be eligible for the current Dual Enrollment Scholarship provided by LC (if this scholarship is discontinued in the future, this area of the articulation agreement will be revisited to accommodate WHSD specifically).

CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT:

1. The LC Director of College Enrollment Partnerships, Lake Region Center Director, and the WHSD Director of Career Services will monitor compliance with the terms of this Agreement.
2. Either institution may withdraw from this Agreement upon written notification directed to the other, except that commitments already in effect for students who have applied to LC will be honored. In the event of a substantial breach, such as, a lack of response to requests for information and a lack of adequate participation, either party may immediately terminate this Agreement.
3. The relationship of the parties to this Agreement shall not be construed to constitute a partnership, joint venture, or any other relationship, other than that of independent contractors.
4. Neither of the parties shall assume any liabilities as a result of this Agreement. As to liability to each other or death to persons, or damages to property, the parties do not waive any defense as a result of entering into this contract. Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver of any immunities afforded by LC by law or otherwise.
5. This Agreement represents the entire understanding between the parties. This Agreement can be modified only in writing with the same formality as the original Agreement.




