Schedule: Session 1 – June 19-June 27 8:00AM-4:00PM and June 28 8:00AM-12:00PM

Session 2 –June 29-July 11 8:00AM-4:00PM and July 12 8:00AM-12:00PM

Registration: Registration will be on June 16, 2023 from 7:00 A.M.to 1:00 P.M.

Payment: Summer School cost will be \$250 per course. The cost of Senior Project presentation is \$75.00.

Full payment is due at time of registration. No refunds will be made.

Courses Offered: English, Math, Science, Social Studies and Senior Project Presentation

HONESDALE HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL POLICY

- * Courses will be offered on an as needed basis, depending on enrollment.
- * Summer School is a supplement to the regular classroom work and a second chance to master the work.
- * Summer School is not a replacement for a course.
- * Summer School is a privilege; each student's application will be reviewed individually.
- * No grade or credit will be awarded until all requirements are met and all materials returned.
- *Students must meet ALL of their financial obligations before registering for summer school.
- * The maximum grade earned will be a "73".
- * Students who demonstrate very low achievement and/or make little effort to succeed during the regular school year will not be eligible for summer school. Students who do not earn a 55% 64% average as a final grade in a course may not be eligible to attend summer school.
- * The instructor is in charge at all times.
- * Students are not allowed to leave school property during breaks.
- * Smoking will not be permitted on school grounds at any time Failure to comply with this policy or any other will result in dismissal.
- * There will be no disciplinary problems tolerated. Students who violate this policy will be dismissed from Summer School. No refunds will be made.
- * Due to the shortened time frame of each summer school session, absence, lateness and early dismissal will not be permitted.

 Dismissal from summer school will result. Students are expected to be in attendance for the full time. Any unexcused missed time will result in dismissal with no refund. All missed class time must be preapproved and must not exceed 8 hours.

 Absence due to extenuating circumstances will be reviewed by the instructor and administration.
- * Honesdale High School students who do not receive credit for their courses because of excessive absences may take summer school courses to regain their credit as per the following schedule:
 - 15+ 25 days absent will require one course to be completed successfully.
 - 25+ 35 days absent will require two courses to be completed successfully.
 - 35+ days absent, summer school is not an option

Regarding lates and early dismissals, any part of an hour counts as a full hour. Students may be dismissed from the summer school program for any late arrivals and early dismissals.

While the Dress Code is relaxed, it is not abolished. Summer attire is acceptable, but school appropriateness is essential.
